Concealed Carry Canada



Thank you for your interest in Concealed Carry Canada's **State of Utah Concealed Firearm Permit** course. While a discussion about the concealed carry of firearms might seem out of place in Canada, a place with many wonderful freedoms, there are other places in the world (many of which you and I travel to often) that believe true freedom can only be had when citizens and visitors alike, have the right to properly defend themselves from those who would take from them something more precious then freedom itself... their lives.

The State of Utah has lead the way in ensuring that their citizens, and those who wish to visit their great state, have the means at their disposal to legally carry, and hopefully never use, a firearm for self-defense. Not only that, but the Utah State Attorney General's office has seen to it that the concealed firearm permits issued by the State of Utah are recognized by at least 27 other states. This fact alone makes Utah's concealed firearm permit one of the most sought after in North America.

Some things for you to consider:

- The Concealed Firearms Permit (CCW) issued to Canadians by the State of Utah has no validity whatsoever within Canada. All of Canada's firearm laws apply without exception, including those regarding the safe storage and transport of firearms to and from ports of exit and entry. In short, while in Canada, the holder of a Utah CCW permit posses nothing more then an interesting piece of picture ID. However, when in Utah or any of the 27 other states that recognize Utah's CCW permit, you are legally authorized to be armed.
- The State of Utah routinely grants non-resident CCW permits, including hundreds each year to Canadians. You must be at least 21 years of age to apply.
- Only individuals with a valid Canadian Firearms Possession and Acquisition License (PAL) will be permitted to attend our classes. In addition, a valid driver's license is required. Please bring your PAL, driver's license and Social Insurance Number with you to class. (SIN required on Utah's application ONLY and is not retained by us)
- All applicants will be subject to a criminal background check conducted by the United States Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). Applicants are required to submit a recent "10 Card" fingerprint sample to facilitate this process.
 Our trained fingerprint technician will take your prints for you during class. Passport quality photos will also be taken in class.
- The State of Utah's CCW permit is widely sought after as it is recognized by 27 other states under reciprocity and other agreements. That is to say, anyone licensed to carry a concealed firearm in the State of Utah is also permitted to do so in at least 27 other states.

Concealed Carry Canada is holding two Utah CCW Permit classes in Calgary, the first on **Saturday January 13th**, **2007**, and a second on **Saturday January 27th**, **2007** (**11:00AM to 4:00PM**). Classes will be held at **The Shooting Edge**, **Bay #4**, **510 77 Avenue S.E. Calgary**, **AB**. There is **NO LIVE FIRE** requirement for this class, so please **NO FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION** in the classroom.
